

Overview

- This report provides a summary of equality and diversity statistics for GSA over the past year, as compared with the Scottish and UK averages, as well as those of other small specialist institutions
- The report allows GSA to benchmark and highlight key differences in protected characteristics which may require investigation, addressing or justification.


Key points

- The proportion of BME students domiciled in the UK at GSA outperforms all of the benchmark measures currently used
- Numbers of those with a disclosed disability is higher than average at GSA, with the highest proportion at GSA studying within the School of Fine Art
- As is the common them with the UK higher education sector, overall there are more female than male students at GSA.
- However, the Mackintosh School of Architecture attracts more male students
- GSA has a higher proportion of students in the 21-24 age bracket due to the nature of the subject where completing a foundation year prior to an undergraduate degree is not uncommon


2011/12 Student Ethnicity (UK Domiciled)







2011/12 Student Disability (All Students)




2011/12 Student Gender (All Students)


■ Male ■ Female
