## English Language Qualifications - 2024/25 Entry

Where a standardised test is required, GSA prefers applicants to provide a test result from LIST 1 (Accepted English Language Tests). Applicants unable to provide a test result from LIST 1 may also consult LIST 2 (Alternative English Language Tests and Qualifications).

The exact entry requirements will be shown in the conditions of your offer letter. All test results must be dated within 2 years of your programme start date.
