

### APPLICATION PROCESS

#### SELECTION CRITERIA

We take into consideration first those who;

- Live out with the daily travel distance.
- Are new to the GSA and independent living.
- Declare a special need/disability which impacts housing requirements please contact the accommodation office at <a href="mailto:accommodation@gsa.ac.uk">accommodation@gsa.ac.uk</a> to request the guidance note.

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

- Applications open in late February/early March.
- GSA course offer holders will be sent an email from the accommodation office with full details on how to make an online housing application.
- Applications will then be reviewed alongside the selection criteria.
- Once the application has been processed, applicants will receive direct email correspondence from the accommodation office containing the outcome of the housing application.
- If we are in a position to offer housing, applicants will be invited back to the accommodation portal to select a room, sign the tenancy agreement, and pay the non-refundable £125 rent prepayment. Please note that this payment will be deducted from the rent balance after check-in.
- If we are not in a position to offer GSA housing, we will refer applicants to the <u>GSA Student Support Services</u> for advice and support on finding housing in the private sector.

#### APPLICATION TOP TIPS

- Apply as soon as possible after receiving the housing information email.
- Declare any special needs or disabilities within the online application.
- Upload a profile picture which will allow staff to identify new residents on arrival.
- Take time to complete the profile so the best decision can be made when self-selecting the room and/or flat.
- Get in touch with us if you have any issues or queries.

## HOW LONG IS THE TENANCY AND DO I NEED TO MOVE OUT DURING THE WINTER/SPRING BREAK?

Tenancy length durations vary depending on course length. We offer semester stays to those staying for only one semester, 39 weeks to undergraduates, and 39 or 51 weeks to postgraduates. No, residents do not need to vacate during the breaks. The bedroom/flat is accessible for the entirely of the tenancy.

#### WHAT IF I WANT TO CANCEL MY TENANCY AND MOVE OUT?

Once checked in and keys have been collected, residents are committed to the tenancy for the tenancy length booked, and obligated to pay the rent in full, unless no longer studying at the GSA through course withdrawal or leave of absence.

#### WHAT IS THE LOCAL AREA LIKE?

One of the friendliest cities in the UK, Glasgow is bursting with cultural attractions, places to eat, pubs, bars, and night clubs, and a lively music and comedy scene with The Stand, King Tut's Wah Wah Hut, The SSE Hydro, and plenty more in close proximity of the The Glasgow School of Art's Halls of Residences. We recommend checking out the Glasgow Art Map, which showcases galleries and exhibitions across the city. The slogan People Make Glasgow truly represents the city, making student life incredibly special. Our city centre sites are a 5 minute walk from local amenities on Sauchiehall Street, and the GSA Reid building.
