APPLICATION PROCESS

SELECTION CRITERIA

The GSA Forres housing in only available to postgraduate students studying in the GSA Highlands and Islands campus.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applications open in late February or early March.
- If you receive a course offer by the GSA you will receive an automatic email from the accommodation office with full details on how to make an online application.
- We will review your application alongside our selection criteria.
- Once your online application has been processed you will receive direct email correspondence containing the outcome of your housing application.
- If we are in a position to offer you housing, you will be invited back to our accommodation portal to select your room, sign the tenancy agreement and pay the non-refundable £125 rent prepayment. Please note that this will be deducted from the rent balance after check-in.

APPLICATION TOP TIPS

- · Apply as soon as you have received the housing information email.
- Declare any special needs or disabilities within the online application.
- Upload a profile selfie so staff can identify you on arrival.
- Take your time to complete your profile so you can make the best decision when self selecting your flat.
- Make sure you are applying for housing in Forres rather than Glasgow if you are studying in the GSA Highlands and Islands campus.
- Get in touch with us if you have any issues or queries.

CAN I BRING MY PET?

Animals are not allowed in halls, even for a short period. This is written into the tenancy agreement. Some exceptions do apply. For the GSA animal policy, please email <u>accommodation@gsa.ac.uk</u>.

WHAT IF I HOLD AN OFFER FOR FORRES AND GLASGOW?

If you have not decided on whether to accept a place to study at the GSA in Glasgow or Forres, you can still make a housing application. Please email <u>accommodation@gsa.ac.uk</u> to inform us.

HOW LONG IS THE TENANCY AND DO I NEED TO MOVE OUT DURING THE WINTER/SPRING BREAK?

We offer a 51 week tenancy (September-September) to postgraduates studying in the GSA Highlands & Islands campus. No, you do not require to vacate during the breaks. Your bedroom/flat is your home for the entirely of the tenancy.

CAN I BRING A FRIEND, FAMILY MEMBER OR PARTNER?

You are able to have visitors for a maximum of 3 nights within 1 month. You cannot move anyone into the properties on a permanent basis. This is written into the tenancy agreement.

WHAT IF I WANT TO CANCEL MY TENANCY AND MOVE OUT?

Once you have checked in and collected your keys, you are committed to the tenancy for the tenancy length booked and obligated to pay the rent in full, unless you are no longer studying at the GSA.

WHAT IS THE LOCAL AREA LIKE?

Situated in Moray, about 27 miles north east of the Highland capital of Inverness, the town boasts a classic castle with impressive parks and gardens. Home to a number of craft shops and art galleries, Forres and the surrounding area hosts a number of cultural events, including the carnival style Culture Day and bi-annual Findhorn Bay Arts Festival in September. You will never get bored of the scenic forest and coastal walks available, alongside the sand and pebbles beaches. Our accommodation sites are within walking distance of local transport and food shops and pharmacies.
