

APPLICATION PROCESS

SELECTION CRITERIA

We take into consideration first those who;

- · Live out with the daily travel distance
- · Are new to the GSA and independent living
- Declare a special need/disability which impacts housing requirements

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applications open in late February or early March.
- If you receive a course offer by the GSA you will receive an automatic email from the accommodation office with full details on how to make an online application.
- We will review your application alongside our selection criteria.
- Once your online application has been processed you will receive direct email correspondence containing the outcome of your housing application.
- If we are in a position to offer you housing, you will be invited back to our accommodation portal to select your room, sign the tenancy agreement and pay the non-refundable £125 rent prepayment. Please note that this will be deducted from the rent balance after check-in.
- If we are not in a position to offer you GSA housing, we will refer you to the <u>GSA Student Support</u> <u>Services</u> for advice and support on finding housing in the private sector.

APPLICATION TOP TIPS

- · Apply as soon as you have received the housing information email.
- Declare any special needs or disabilities within the online application.
- Upload a profile selfie so staff can identify you on arrival.
- Take your time to complete your profile so you can make the best decision when self selecting your flat.

WHAT IS RESLIFE?

Reslife is a team based within our accommodation who assist with the pastoral care of residents and aim to build a strong and inclusive community. ARE THERE ADAPTED FACILITIES/OPTIONS?

CAN I BRING MY PET?

Animals are not allowed in halls, even for a short period. This is written into the tenancy agreement. Some exceptions do apply. For the GSA animal policy, please email accommodation@gsa.ac.uk.

CAN RETURNING STUDENTS APPLY FOR GSA HOUSING?

We can no longer facilitate returning students to halls unless in extenuating circumstances. If you feel that this applies to you, please email accommodation@gsa.ac.uk to discuss this further.

HOW LONG IS THE TENANCY AND DO I NEED TO MOVE OUT DURING THE WINTER/SPRING BREAK?

Tenancy length durations vary depending on your course length. We offer semester stays to those staying for only one semester, 39 weeks to undergraduates and 39 or 51 weeks to postgraduates. No, you do not require to vacate during the breaks. Your bedroom and flat is your home for the entirely of the tenancy.

WHAT IF I WANT TO CANCEL MY TENANCY AND MOVE OUT?

Once you have checked in and collected your keys, you are committed to the tenancy for the tenancy length booked and obligated to pay the rent in full, unless you are no longer studying at the GSA.

WHAT IS THE LOCAL AREA LIKE?

One of the friendliest cities in the UK, Glasgow is bursting with cultural attractions, places to eat, pubs, bars, and night clubs, and a lively music and comedy scene with The Stand, King Tut's Wah Wah Hut, The SSE Hydro, and plenty more in close proximity of the The Glasgow School of Art's Halls of Residences. The slogan *People Make Glasgow* truly represents the city, making student life incredibly special. Our city centre sites are a 2 minute walk from Sauchiehall Street where you will also find clothing, food shops and pharmacies.
