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APPLICATION PROCESS

SELECTION CRITERIA

We take into consideration first those who;

- Live out with the daily travel distance.
- Are new to the GSA and independent living.
- Declare a special need or disability which impacts housing requirements - please contact the accommodation office at accommodation@gsa.ac.uk to request the guidance note.



APPLICATION PROCESS

- GSA housing applications open in March.
- GSA course offer holders will receive an email from the accommodation office with full instructions on how to submit an online housing application.
- Applications will be reviewed in line with the selection criteria
- Once processed, applicants will receive an email from the accommodation office confirming the outcome of their housing application.
- If we are able to offer housing, applicants will be invited back to the accommodation portal to select a room, sign the tenancy agreement, and pay the non-refundable £125 rent pre-payment. Please note that this amount will be deducted from the rent balance after check-in.
- If we are unable to offer GSA housing, we will refer applicants to GSA Student Support Services for guidance and support in finding private sector accommodation.

APPLICATION TOP TIPS

- Apply as soon as possible after receiving the housing information email.
- Declare any special needs or disabilities within the online application.
- Upload a profile picture to help staff identify new residents on arrival.
- Take time to complete the profile section to ensure the best possible match when self-selecting a room and/or flat.

WHAT IS RESLIFE?

ResLife is a dedicated team of current GSA students and residents based within our accommodation, committed to fostering a strong, inclusive, and welcoming community. The Reslife team at GSA Halls focuses on providing a supportive foundation for life in Glasgow and at GSA, helping residents connect with one another through a range of organised events and community building initiatives.

In addition to offering onsite support, Reslife regularly organise activities, some in collaboration with GSA Sustainability, GSA Student Association, and GSA Student Support Services. The team also collate relevant and engaging content for our social media channels.

ARE THERE ADAPTED FACILITIES/OPTIONS?

CAN I BRING MY PET?

Animals are not permitted in halls, even for short periods, as stated in the tenancy agreement. Some exceptions do apply. For the GSA animal policy, please email accommodation@gsa.ac.uk.

CAN RETURNING STUDENTS APPLY FOR GSA HOUSING?

We no longer allocate halls to returning students except in extenuating circumstances. If you believe this applies to you, please email accommodation@gsa.ac.uk.

HOW LONG IS THE TENANCY AND DO I NEED TO MOVE OUT DURING THE WINTER/SPRING BREAK?

Tenancy lengths vary depending on your course. We offer semester stays for study abroad and exchange students, 39 week contracts for undergraduates, and 39 or 51 week options for postgraduates. Residents do not need to vacate during breaks - rooms/flats are accessible for the full duration of the tenancy.

WHAT IF I WANT TO CANCEL MY TENANCY AND MOVE OUT?

Once checked in and keys have been collected, residents are committed to the full tenancy length and liable for the full rent amount unless they are no longer studying at the GSA due to course withdrawal or an approved leave of absence.

WHAT IS THE LOCAL AREA LIKE?

One of the friendliest cities in the UK, Glasgow is bursting with cultural attractions, places to eat, pubs, bars, and night clubs, and a lively music and comedy scene. With [The Stand](#), [King Tut's Wah Wah Hut](#), [The SSE Hydro](#), and plenty more in close proximity of the The Glasgow School of Art's Halls of Residences.
