1. Remit:

- 1.1 To oversee the implementation of the Technician Commitment at GSA.
- 1.2 To represent the views of, and report back progress to, their colleagues.
- 1.3 To contribute to the delivery of the Technician Commitment Action Plan year 1-3.
- 1.4 To monitor the progress and impact of the Action Plan.
- 1.5 To champion the goals of the Technician Commitment across GSA in their everyday work.
The Technician Commitment goals are:
 - a. Visibility
 - b. Recognition
 - c. Career Development
 - d. Sustainability

2. Membership:

- 2.1 The Technician Commitment Group is convened by the Head of TSD.
- 2.2 Members are as follows:
 - Head of TSD (Convenor)
 - One member of TSD Admin staff (Secretary)
 - At least one representative from each technical team: 3d Stow, 3d Reid, SJC, Print, Photo, Textiles, Fashion, Digital Media, Studio Team, Forres/Makerspace
 - One technical manager
 - Union representative
 - HR representative
 - Student representative
 - One member of academic staff
- 2.3 Membership will usually be for 2 years. There will be a 2-yearly call-out for members.
- 2.4 To be quorate, there must be at least half of the members in attendance.

3. Frequency

- 3.1 It is expected that the Group will meet four times annually.
