GSA International Clearing Scholarships 2026/27

The Glasgow School of Art (GSA) is offering **£4,000 scholarships** to undergraduate applicants classified as international fee-paying who receive an offer through Clearing, as a contribution towards the cost of their studies for the 2026/27 academic year.

The Clearing Scholarship is automatically awarded to eligible undergraduate international fee-paying students who apply through Clearing and receive an offer to study at GSA.

Scholarship Value:

£4,000 (a one-off award applied towards the first year's tuition fees only)

Academic Year:

2026/27

Open to:

International fee-paying students

Qualification Level

Undergraduate

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

- Be classified as an international fee-paying student.
- Apply through Clearing and receive an offer to study a full-time undergraduate programme starting in September 2026.
- Receive a formal Clearing offer from GSA.

The scholarship is **not** available to:

- Applicants who already hold an offer from GSA through the main UCAS application cycle.

Terms and Conditions

- If you defer your place of study, the scholarship cannot be deferred and will not be carried forward to a future academic year.
- The GSA reserves the right to amend or withdraw the scholarship at any time.

- The scholarship may be held alongside external funding, provided that the total value of all funding does not exceed 100% of your tuition fees.
- Students may receive a maximum of one GSA Clearing Scholarship.
